### Introduction: St. Luke's Church - Smithfield VA

#### I. Moses - God's Lawgiver (Exodus 19; Deuteronomy 4:44-8:20)

- Moses was chosen by God to lead His people in \_\_\_\_\_ (Exodus 3)
- Moses was chosen to give God's \_\_\_\_\_ to His people (Exodus 19-23)
- Moses was chosen to mediate God's \_\_\_\_\_ with His people (Exodus 19:5-6, 10-15; 24:1-2, 9-10)
  1. Israel will be God's own \_\_\_\_\_ people (Exodus 19:5)
  2. Israel will be a kingdom of \_\_\_\_\_ (Exodus 19:6)
  3. Israel will be a holy \_\_\_\_\_ (Exodus 19:6)

#### II. Jesus - THE Lawgiver (Matthew 5:17-48)

- Moses prophesied that one \_\_\_\_\_ him would one day come from Israel and they must listen to him (Deuteronomy 18:15)

- Jesus is THE Lawgiver:

  3. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ the New Covenant with God's people (Luke 22:20; Hebrews 9:1-15)
  4. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ God's people (Luke 4:18-21; Romans 8:1-2; Galatians 1:3-5; Colossians 1:13-14)
  5. Jesus makes God's people \_\_\_\_\_ (Romans 1:16-17; 10:1-13; 1 Corinthians 1:30; Philippians 3:7-9)
  6. Jesus makes God's people a kingdom of \_\_\_\_\_ and a holy \_\_\_\_\_ (Exodus 19:5-6; 1 Peter 2:9)
